- June 21-26, 2009, Revere School Community/Greater Grand Crossing Neighborhood, City of Chicago: Advisory Services Panel convened by the City and NCI to respond to collective stakeholder interests that included the creation of a lifelong learning campus and a sustainable environment that included urban agriculture and related industries.
